Public Sector Employment and Management Act 1993

<u>DETERMINATION NUMBER 1098 OF 2001</u> (REISSUE)

I, JOANNE NORTON, the Acting Commissioner for Public Employment in pursuance of section 14(2) of the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act 1993* and with reference to section 13(a) of that Act, determine that:

- 1. Where an employee is required to handle toxic substances in the course of undertaking duties, the employee shall be paid an allowance.
- 2. The allowance shall be paid at the rate of sixty (60) cents per hour whilst the employee is required to handle the toxic substance(s).
- 3. The allowance shall only be paid to an employee performing duties in the following workplaces of the Department of Primary Industry and Fisheries:
 - a) Plant, Soil and Water Laboratory
 - b) Plant Pathology Laboratory
 - c) Entomology Laboratory
 - d) Veterinary Laboratory (Virology and Pathology)
- 4. The allowance shall not be paid to an employee to which Determination 1015 of 1999 applies.
- 5. This determination will cease to have effect on the nominal expiry of the *Northern Territory Public Sector 2021 2025 Enterprise Agreement*, or upon the commencement of a new Agreement, whichever is the later.
