Public Sector Employment and Management Act 1993

DETERMINATION NUMBER 1098 OF 2001
(REISSUE)

I, JOANNE NORTON, the Acting Commissioner for Public Employment in pursuance of section 14(2) of the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act 1993* and with reference to section 13(a) of that Act, determine that:

1. Where an employee is required to handle toxic substances in the course of undertaking duties, the employee shall be paid an allowance.
2. The allowance shall be paid at the rate of sixty (60) cents per hour whilst the employee is required to handle the toxic substance(s).
3. The allowance shall only be paid to an employee performing duties in the following workplaces of the Department of Primary Industry and Fisheries:
 - a) Plant, Soil and Water Laboratory
 - b) Plant Pathology Laboratory
 - c) Entomology Laboratory
 - d) Veterinary Laboratory (Virology and Pathology)
4. The allowance shall not be paid to an employee to which Determination 1015 of 1999 applies.
5. This determination will cease to have effect on the nominal expiry of the *Northern Territory Public Sector 2021 – 2025 Enterprise Agreement*, or upon the commencement of a new Agreement, whichever is the later.
