RELOCATION ALLOWANCE - ALICE SPRINGS

I, NICOLE HURWOOD, Commissioner for Public Employment, pursuant to section 14(2) of the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act 1993* and with reference to section 13(a) of that Act, determine that:

- 1. For the purpose of Public Sector Employment and Management By-law 28 Relocation Allowance, the Chief Executive Officer of the Department of Education and Training may approve the payment of the allowance up to a maximum of 10 fortnights, under By-law 28.5 to an employee relocating to Alice Springs.
- 2. This Determination applies to employees covered by the Northern Territory Public Sector Non-Contract Principals, Teachers and Assistant Teachers' 2021-2024 Enterprise Agreement ('the Agreement') or its successor.
- 3. The purpose of the Determination is to address recruitment and retention issues in Alice Springs.
- 4. This Determination is to take effect on the date it is signed.
- 5. An employee who was employed on 18 January 2023, and continued to be employed on the date this determination is signed, and who worked between 18 January 2023 and the day immediately before this Determination is signed (the transitional period) may be eligible for relocation allowance under paragraph 1.
- 6. This Determination will cease to have effect on 31 December 2027 unless revoked earlier.
