SELECT WITHOUT ADVERTISING – SUBSEQUENT VACANCIES

I, KENNETH DONALD SIMPSON, the Commissioner for Public Employment –

- (a) under section 14 of the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act* (the Act) and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke Public Sector Instrument Number 6 of 12 July 2000; and
- (b) under section 30(1)(b) of the Act and with reference to section 42 of the *Interpretation Act*, approve the Chief Executive Officer of an Agency, in accordance with the conditions specified in the Schedule, selecting, without advertising, a person or an employee to perform duties that are to be performed for a period exceeding 6 months.

SCHEDULE

SELECT WITHOUT ADVERTISING SUBSEQUENT VACANCIES

If there is a vacancy for a person to perform duties and –

- (a) the vacancy is advertised, with the selection process resulting in one or more suitable applicants; and
- (b) within six months of the original advertisement the same vacancy arises again, or another vacancy to perform identical duties at the same designation arises,

without further advertising –

- (c) one of the suitable applicants referred to in paragraph (a) may be selected in accordance with the merit principle, provided that -
 - (i) the selection occurs within six months of the original advertisement; and
 - (ii) the selection is notified on the Northern Territory Government job vacancies website or as otherwise directed by the Commissioner.
