PUBLIC SECTOR INSTRUMENT NO. 26
APPROVAL TO SELECT WITHOUT ADVERTISING

I, Kenneth Donald Simpson, Commissioner for Public Employment:

- (a) under section 30(1)(b) of the Public Sector Employment and Management Act and with reference to section 42 of the Interpretation Act, approve the Chief Executive Officer of an Agency selecting, without advertising, a person to perform duties as an ongoing employee in accordance with the following conditions:
- (i) the person applied for an advertised position for ongoing employment and was selected for that position in accordance with the merit principle; and
 - (ii) the person is a New Zealand citizen and holds a Special Category visa; and
 - (iii) because of the person's New Zealand citizenship, the person was employed on a fixed period contract for the position; and
 - (iv) there is no other reason the person was not employed on an ongoing basis for the position.
- (b) under section 30(4) of the Public Sector Employment and Management Act, direct that the selection of a person under paragraph (a) is not required to be notified.
