REVOCATION OF DETERMINATION 1022 of 2018

I, VICKI TELFER, Commissioner for Public Employment, pursuant to section 14(2) of the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act*, and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, hereby revoke Determination Number 1022 of 2018.

DETERMINATION NUMBER 1044 OF 2022

- I, VICKI TELFER, Commissioner for Public Employment, pursuant to section 14(2) of the Public Sector Employment and Management Act 1993 and with reference to section 13(a) of that Act, determine that:
 - 1. The following provisions will apply to employees of the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics at the Technical level 6 designation in position numbers 26452 and 11254:
 - 2. Employees shall be entitled to overtime payments in accordance with Clause 59 of the Northern Territory Public Sector 2021-2025 Enterprise Agreement (the Agreement), provided that:
 - a. the extra duty performed is part of the required duties within the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics;
 - b. time off in lieu or other flexible work arrangements are unavailable or unable to be used; and
 - c. the overtime is approved in advance by the Chief Executive Officer or delegate of the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics.
 - 3. Employees shall be entitled to restriction duty payments in accordance with Clause 62 of the Agreement provided that:
 - a. the restriction duty is part of the required duties within the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics; and

- b. the restriction duty is approved in advance by the Chief Executive Officer or delegate of the Department Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics.
- 4. This Determination is to have effect on and from 7 April 2022.
- 5. This Determination will cease to have effect on the nominal expiry date of the Agreement, or upon the commencement of a new Agreement, whichever is the later, unless revoked earlier.
