

**Northern Territory of Australia**

***Public Sector Employment and Management Act***

**Determination Number 16 of 2011**

I, GRAHAM DOUGLAS SYMONS, the Commissioner for Public Employment for the Northern Territory in pursuance of section 14(2) of the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act* and with reference to section 13(a) of that Act, determine:

1. a Chief Executive Officer may grant an employee leave without pay for a period of training and/or deployment, with the Australian Civilian Corps;
2. the period of leave does not break the continuity of employment, but does not count as service for the accrual of any entitlement;
3. the period of training and/or deployment with the Australian Civilian Corps will be recognised as service for long service leave purposes except for accrual purposes; and
4. the Northern Territory Public Sector accepts no liability for any sickness or injury caused by or arising out of the period of training and/or deployment with the Australian Civilian Corps.
