EXECUTIVE CONTRACT PRINCIPALS – SIX WEEKS RECREATION LEAVE

I, VICKI TELFER, Commissioner for Public Employment, in pursuance of section 14(2) of the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act 1993* (the Act) and with reference to section 13(a) of that Act, determine that the following recreation leave provisions apply to Executive Contract Principals in lieu of those contained in Determination 13 of 2011, Determination 5 of 2019 and Determination 10 of 2019:

- 1. An Executive Contract Principal progressively accrues six (6) weeks paid recreation leave per Employment Year.
- 2. An Executive Contract Principal must take a minimum of four (4)weeks recreation leave within each Employment Year unless otherwise approved by the Employer; and
- 3. The Employer must direct an Executive Contract Principal to take a period of recreation leave where he/she has accrues in excess of twelve (12) weeks recreation leave, or where the Employer's enterprise is shut down for a period, e.g. between Christmas and New Year.

This Determination is to have effect on and from 1 July 2012.
