I, Nicole Hurwood, Commissioner for Public Employment, pursuant to section 14(2) of the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act 1993* and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act 1978*, revoke Determination Number 1036 of 2022.

EXCESS TRAVEL TIME

I, Nicole Hurwood, Commissioner for Public Employment, pursuant to section 14(2) of the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act 1993* and with reference to section 13(a) of that Act, determine that:

1. An employee performing the duties of Probation and Parole Officer at the Administrative Officer 5, Administrative Officer 6 and Professional 2 designation; or Community Work Coordinator at the Administrative Officer 5 designation, within the Department of the Attorney-General and Justice shall be:
 - (a) entitled to the Excess Travelling Time under clause 49 of the *Northern Territory Public Sector 2021-2025 Enterprise Agreement* (the Agreement), for travel to remote communities outside of standard working hours for the purpose of:
 - offender supervision;
 - case management;
 - stakeholder engagement;
 - program delivery; and
 - circuit court duties.
 - (b) entitled to be paid at the rates specified under clause 49.8 of the Agreement.
2. Excess travel time shall be paid in recognition of the regular requirement of travel to remote communities.
3. This Determination is to have effect on the date it is signed.
4. This Determination will cease to have effect on the nominal expiry date of the *Northern Territory Public Sector 2021 - 2025 Enterprise Agreement*, or upon the commencement of a new enterprise agreement, whichever is the later, unless revoked earlier.
