

## **24. LOW FLYING ALLOWANCE**

### Entitlement

- 24.1 An employee (other than an employee who is a flight crew member) who is required to perform duties in an aircraft which for all or any part of the flight is required to fly at a height of 700 metres or less above ground level for the purpose of the operation on which it is engaged to enable those duties to be performed, will be entitled to be paid an allowance at a rate as determined by the Commissioner, for each hour or part of an hour for the whole of the time for such flight.
- 24.2 An allowance under by-law 24.1 will not be paid where take-offs and landings are the only part of a flight where the aircraft is at or below 700 metres regardless of how many landings and take-offs are made during the journey, and the employee is not required to perform duty specifically during those take-offs or landings.
