

**Northern Territory of Australia*****Public Sector Employment and Management Act*****REVOCATION OF DETERMINATION NUMBER 1 OF 2018**

I, CRAIG JOHN ALLEN, the Commissioner for Public Employment, pursuant to section 14(2) of the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act*, and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, hereby revoke Determination Number 1 of 2018 from close of business 31 December 2018.

**DETERMINATION NUMBER 1 OF 2019**

I, CRAIG JOHN ALLEN, the Commissioner for Public Employment for the Northern Territory, in pursuance to section 14(2) of the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act* and with reference to section 13(a) of that Act, determine that the allowances specified in Column 1 of the Schedule, shall be payable at the rate shown in Column 2 of that Schedule, except that where permitted pursuant to a power under the Act or By-Laws, a Chief Executive Officer of an Agency has determined a rate in respect of a particular provision, that rate will prevail in that Agency.

This Determination is to have effect on and from 1 January 2019.
