VOTE for a new Enterprise Agreement

As reported in [Bulletin 9](#) the Single Bargaining Unit provided in-principle support for a new Territory Generation Enterprise Agreement.

Drafting of the new agreement is complete and a ballot process can now commence.

Ballot Process – Your Vote is Confidential

The ballot process will be conducted by the Northern Territory Electoral Commission (NTEC).

On Monday 4 February 2019 you will be sent information regarding the proposed 2018 – 2022 Territory Generation Enterprise Agreement, including a link to a copy of the proposed agreement and an explanatory document highlighting the changes compared with your current agreement. Hard copies of these documents will also be available throughout your workplace.

The NTEC ballot will be conducted via an **electronic** vote. An email including a unique identifier will be sent to you at your Territory Generation email address on Tuesday 12 February 2019, along with steps on how to cast and submit your electronic vote.

The electronic ballot will be emailed to your address details contained in epass. If you won't have access to your Territory Generation email during the ballot period; would prefer for your electronic vote to be sent to your private email account; or your email details have recently changed, please contact Sue Whyte at the NT Electoral Commission on netvote.NTEC@nt.gov.au or 8999 7643, and provide your updated details as soon as possible.

Please note, if you are accessing your emails through NTG webmail, the NTG system will not allow you to access the secure voting website. Employees will need to provide an alternative email address if required in these cases.

The ballot count will be conducted at NTEC offices in Darwin, Level 3 TCG Centre 80 Mitchell Street, Darwin.
