New classification structure to commence on 1 January 2020

It is anticipated the new classification structure will commence on 1 January 2020 subject to the Fair Work Commission approval of the new enterprise agreement. It is important to note that the current structure will remain in place for those AHPs that will not be eligible to transition as at 1 January 2020.

As communicated in <u>Bulletin 9</u> AHPs were advised of the requirement to update their portfolios to assist a Transitional Panel to assess suitability to transition to the new classification structure.

AHPs will have the opportunity to vote on the new Enterprise Agreement in the coming weeks and receive their pay increases from August 2018 if the vote is supported.
