

29. TEMPERATE CLOTHING ALLOWANCE

Interpretation

29.1 For the purpose of this By-law:

“temperate location” means a place south of the Tropic of Capricorn or north of the Tropic of Cancer.

Entitlement

29.2 If an employee whose normal place of employment is not in a temperate location, is directed to travel to a temperate location for the purpose of official duty, the Chief Executive Officer may approve reimbursement of the cost of temperate clothing purchased.

29.3 A temperate clothing allowance will not exceed the maximum amount determined by the Commissioner.

29.4 The Chief Executive Officer will determine the conditions applicable to his or her agency, in relation to the payment (ie purchases and/or hiring) and the extent of clothing necessary for temperate climates.
