DETERMINATION NUMBER 1023 OF 2022

RAPID RESPONSE ALLOWANCE –
CASUAL EMPLOYEES – SEXUAL ASSUALT REFERRAL CENTRE

I, VICKI TELFER, Commissioner for Public Employment, pursuant to section 14(2) of the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act 1993* and with reference to section 13(a) of that Act, determine that:

- 1) Casual employees engaged to provide after-hours service delivery within the Sexual Assault Referral Centre (SARC), Department of Health, shall be entitled to Rapid Response Allowance (the Allowance) as specified in this Determination.
- 2) Rapid Response Allowance will:
 - a. be paid at the rates specified in the Schedule of this Determination; and
 - b. be paid to an employee based in Darwin or Alice Springs.
- 3) The allowance is payable where the casual employee has been directed to hold themselves in readiness to perform duty that may be required through the after-hours SARC service.
- 4) The allowance is not payable where the casual employee does not hold themselves at the required degree of readiness, or does not follow the direction to hold themselves in readiness, to perform duty that may be required through the after-hours SARC service.
- 5) Payment of the allowance is for all telephone calls and returns to duty providing that, where the total time involved in both telephone calls and /or return to duty accumulates to exceed one hour in any night or day and night, then normal casual payments will be paid for the time in excess of one hour.
- 6) This Determination is to have effect on and from 7 April 2022.
- 7) This Determination will cease to have effect from the nominal expiry date of the Northern Territory Public Sector 2021 - 2025 Enterprise Agreement or upon the commencement of the a new enterprise agreement, whichever is later, unless revoked earlier.
