DETERMINATION NUMBER 1063 OF 2023

MARKET ALLOWANCE – SPECIALIST MEDICAL OFFICERS

NATIONAL CRITICAL CARE AND TRAUMA RESPONSE CENTRE

I, VICKI TELFER, Commissioner for Public Employment, pursuant to section 14(2) of the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act 1993* and with reference to section 13(a) of that Act, determine that:

1. A Specialist Medical Officer performing the full duties of a Specialist Medical Officer in the National Critical Care and Trauma Response Centre, Department of Health, will be paid a Market Allowance (the Allowance), in accordance with the following:
 - (a) The Allowance shall be paid on a fortnightly basis at the rate of 40% of the Specialist Medical Officer's base annual salary.
 - (b) The Allowance shall be paid proportionally to the Specialist Medical Officer's contracted hours of work.
 - (c) The Allowance shall be paid during periods of paid leave.
 - (d) The Allowance will not count for the calculation of penalty payments or overtime payments and will not be paid during period of unpaid leave.
 - (e) Where the Specialist Medical Officer is entitled to the Practitioner Allowance (i.e. 30% of base annual salary) under clause 25 of the *Medical Officers Northern Territory Public Sector 2022 – 2025 Enterprise Agreement* (the Agreement), the Allowance shall be paid in lieu of the Practitioner Allowance.
 - (f) The Allowance shall cease if the Specialist Medical Officer becomes eligible for and is in receipt of the Specialist Private Practice Allowance under clause 22 of the Agreement.
2. This Determination shall have effect on and from 26 July 2023.
3. This Determination will cease to have effect on the nominal expiry date of the Agreement, or upon the commencement of a new enterprise agreement, whichever is the later, unless revoked earlier.
