DETERMINATION NUMBER 1063 OF 2023

MARKET ALLOWANCE – SPECIALIST MEDICAL OFFICERS NATIONAL CRITICAL CARE AND TRAUMA RESPONSE CENTRE

I, VICKI TELFER, Commissioner for Public Employment, pursuant to section 14(2) of the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act 1993* and with reference to section 13(a) of that Act, determine that:

- A Specialist Medical Officer performing the full duties of a Specialist Medical Officer in the National Critical Care and Trauma Response Centre, Department of Health, will be paid a Market Allowance (the Allowance), in accordance with the following:
 - (a) The Allowance shall be paid on a fortnightly basis at the rate of 40% of the Specialist Medical Officer's base annual salary.
 - (b) The Allowance shall be paid proportionally to the Specialist Medical Officer's contracted hours of work.
 - (c) The Allowance shall be paid during periods of paid leave.
 - (d) The Allowance will not count for the calculation of penalty payments or overtime payments and will not be paid during period of unpaid leave.
 - (e) Where the Specialist Medical Officer is entitled to the Practitioner Allowance (i.e. 30% of base annual salary) under clause 25 of the *Medical Officers Northern Territory Public Sector 2022 2025 Enterprise Agreement* (the Agreement), the Allowance shall be paid in lieu of the Practitioner Allowance.
 - (f) The Allowance shall cease if the Specialist Medical Officer becomes eligible for and is in receipt of the Specialist Private Practice Allowance under clause 22 of the Agreement.
- 2. This Determination shall have effect on and from 26 July 2023.
- 3. This Determination will cease to have effect on the nominal expiry date of the Agreement, or upon the commencement of a new enterprise agreement, whichever is the later, unless revoked earlier.
