

PART 5 – REMOTE LOCALITY PROVISIONS

42. GENERAL

Interpretation

42.1 For the purposes of the by-laws in this part:

A remote locality is defined as a town, place, community or locality, outside the environs of Darwin, Katherine and Alice Springs, where access to health, education, social, financial, emergency, communication and professional support services are limited. The correlation of these factors, including the costs of goods and services, shall be considered when determining categories of remoteness.

"remote locality" means a category 1 remote locality, a category 2 remote locality or a category 3 remote locality.

"category 1 remote locality", "category 2 remote locality" or "category 3 remote locality" means a locality declared by the Commissioner as such.

Eligibility

42.2 The provisions of this part apply to and in relation to an employee whose normal place of employment is in a remote locality.

42.3 The conditions prescribed under this part are in addition to any other conditions under the Act.
