

# Have you lodged your vote on the proposed new Power and Water Enterprise Agreement?

## Bulletin 14

*\*This bulletin only applies to employees covered by the 2015 – 2018 Power and Water Enterprise Agreement\**

All Power and Water Corporation (PWC) employees covered by the above enterprise agreement are eligible to vote and I encourage you to participate. For your vote to count it must be received by the NT Electoral Commission (NTEC) by 10.00 am Tuesday 29 January 2019. If you have received an email from NTEC then you are eligible to vote and can do so now.

If you haven't received your ballot please contact Sue Whyte at NTEC on [netvote.NTEC@nt.gov.au](mailto:netvote.NTEC@nt.gov.au) or 8999 7643 as soon as possible with your updated details.

A pay rise of 2.5% per annum will become payable from 26 July 2018 if a majority of you who vote, vote **YES** in the ballot, which will ensure you receive backpay as soon as possible.

### Your vote is confidential

The Northern Territory Electoral Commission is an independent authority who manages the ballot process and counting of the votes.

The NTEC ballot process ensures that all employee personal details remain confidential, and that individual voting preferences cannot be identified. Your AGS number is required for electronic voting so NTEC can ensure that all votes are from eligible employees but this validation process is not linked to how your vote is cast.

### Make your vote count

Every vote is important and I encourage you to have your say by casting a formal vote.
