Bargaining Update

Representatives from this Office and Territory Generation have commenced negotiations for a new Territory Generation Enterprise Agreement with representatives of the Electrical Trades Union (ETU), Australian Manufacturing Workers' Union (AMWU), Community and Public Sector Union (CPSU), Professionals Australia (PA), and an individual bargaining representative.

The parties have adopted a collaborative approach to bargaining and as part of this approach, details of a formal offer for a new agreement will be made after the parties have considered and discussed the bargaining issues.

Treasurer's Budget Announcement and Current Negotiations

The NT Treasurer's recent budget announcement included a change to the NTPS Wages Policy effective from 1 October 2018. This change to the wages policy should not affect the current bargaining process as I am committed to working with the bargaining representatives to resolve the negotiations in a timely manner before 1 October 2018.

Next Step

Regular weekly meetings are being scheduled to progress bargaining and you will continue to be kept informed of developments throughout the negotiations.
